

**King William County Electoral Board
Meeting Minutes – May 17, 2023**

The King William County Electoral Board met at the office of the General Registrar on Wednesday, May 17, 2023, in accordance with Virginia State Code 24.2-107.

Call to Order: The Chair called the meeting to order at 10:01AM

New Business:

- **Drawing of Districts for Staggard Terms- Per Ordinance 03-23**

- The Electoral Board, under the direction of the King William County Ordinance 03-23, randomly selecting 2 Districts to run for a two (2) year term this upcoming November Election to start the staggering of terms of the Board of Supervisors and School Board Members for King William County. The General Registrar began the meeting by reading the approved Ordinance in its entirety. The General Registrar then proceeded to explain the process of drawing the numbers. The General Registrar presented slips of paper of all the same size and blank. She then proceeded to write the number of each district on individual slips of paper, one at a time. Each slip of paper was folded 2 ways and then placed in a basket. Once all district numbers were placed in the basket 2 numbers were drawn to determine who would serve a 2-year term. Mr. Hughes drew the first number, District 1. Mr. McAllister drew the second number, District 5. The General Registrar stated that she would communicate this information to any candidates that have already qualified to be on the ballot and will also notify any potential candidates.
