7. Managers' Report

a. Program Reports

Lindsey Catlett asked about a possibility of field hockey or lacrosse coming to King William in the future.

i. After School Program

We have 72 kids registered at this time for next school year. There are only 100 spots available for the program.

ii. Summer Sneakers

We kicked off Summer Sneakers this week. At this time we still remain completely full. We have field trips planned each week except for this week and the short week of July 4th. We also have a lot of good organizations coming in. Veda asked when the ice cream truck came? Kayla responds with every Friday.

iii. Spring Soccer

Spring soccer ended with a successful season with 215 kids playing. We are looking forward to the fall season!

iv. Adult Kickball League

Adult Kickball starts next week, playing at 6:30 on Tuesdays and Thursdays for 10 weeks.

v. Blastball

Blastball registration closes on June 18th and they will begin playing on July 12th. Currently we have a little over 20 kids registered.

vi. Senior Programs

Senior programs continue to be going well.

vii. Fitness Classes

All of our fitness classes are running normally and are at max capacity.

viii. Fall Soccer

Fall soccer opens up next week. Stewart asked, are they usually the same kids that play in the fall? Kayla stated that some were yes, but some may be new as well as they may want to try a new sport.

b. Facility Reports

i. Community Center

Our Community Center is operating as normal. We have no big events currently.

ii. Recreation Park

Bathrooms Doors

At the park, the bathroom doors on the restrooms are being replaced to help with people not having to go up and unlock and lock the restrooms on the weekends for pavilion rentals. The new doors will have a key code pad on them.

Walking Trail

Phase one of the trails at the park are complete. We are just waiting for signage and trash cans. Picnic tables are already in place. Already looking into how we expand the trail and make it longer for the community.

Concession Stand Roll Up Window

We are having a roll up door installed to help with the long line issues that King William Little League has been dealing with at the concession stand.

8. Other Agency Reports

a. King William Little League

KWLL-It is the last week of little league practices and games. All star teams are being picked tonight. We will also be preparing for Fall ball. Little league has done something different in division 5. They will be rotating who will be hosting the all-star tournament. This year Essex will be hosting. We are also trying to complete the Batting cages at the park.

b. King William Raiders Youth Football and Cheer

Registration is now open. We are looking for coaches and players. This year we are offering girls flag football. It will be played 5 on 5. We will have an 8, 10, 12 and possibly a 14-year-old group. Practice will only be once a week once school starts for the girls' flag football. We are working on jerseys and raising money for the program. Lindsey asked about 5-7 year olds. Corey states that they have a 5-6 that is coed regular flag . And any 7-year-old is welcome to sign a play-up form and play with the 8-year-old team.

c. West Point YMCA

This summer is his first summer in his new role. L.A. is planning a basketball camp for small kids and middle and high schools. We would like to do a tournament by the end of the summer, maybe kickball or softball. I am looking into coed flag football since participation has fallen in high school football here in West Point. We have hopes to have more programs in the future. Veda asked, Do you all have a summer day camp? Yes, we started our day camp this week and it runs until the middle of August. He said they do get a couple of participants from surrounding counties. But mostly West Point residents. Veda asked if he saw any future

opportunities to work with King William Parks and Recreation. He said yes he did. L.A. asked do we offer volleyball? Kayla replied, not at this time. L.A. was thinking about a volleyball camp in the future. L.A. stated that he is looking forward to collaborating with kickball next season. LA asked about adult softball. Kayla replied, we don't have Adult Softball at this time.

Stewart says it is good to see everyone. Bill states that he thinks that we are doing great job here at parks and recreation.
