a. Program Reports

The Halloween event went extremely well. We had a truck or treat, games and crafts, and a haunted trail. Troy stated that it got busy real fast and that they gave away 650 pieces of candy. All and all, it was a good turnout. Kayla stated that we are guessing about 1000 people attended the event. We finished the trail around 9:30p.m. Some kids attended both the schools and the park Halloween events, which was good to see.

v. Reindeer Run
