Meeting Minutes – March 6, 2024

The King William County Electoral Board met at the Board Meeting Room of the Administration Building, located at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William Virginia, on Wednesday, March 6, 2024, to consider canvass resulting from the March 5th Dual Party Presidential Primary Election. Canvass of the votes by the Board is provided for in Virginia Code Section 24.2-671 governing the activities of the Virginia State Board of Elections.

Call to Order: Chair Hughes called the meeting to order at 11:06 a.m.

Canvass of the March 5, 2024 Dual Party Presidential Primary Election: The March 5, 2024 Dual Party Presidential Primary Election results were reviewed and confirmed for each precinct by the Board.

Provisional Ballot Meeting:

(Closed Session)

At 11:50 a.m. Mr. Breeden motioned to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing provisional ballots submitted for the March 5, 2024 election. The motion was seconded by Ms. Hall. approved by a unanimous voice vote.

(Open Session)

At 11:51 a.m. Mr. Hughes moved to return to open meeting session. The motion was seconded by Mr. Breeden. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote.
