Meeting Minutes – June 20, 2024

The King William County Electoral Board met at the Board Meeting Room of the Administration Building, located at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William Virginia, on Thursday, June 20, 2024, to consider canvass resulting from the June 18th Dual Party Primary Election. Canvass of the votes by the Board is provided for in Virginia Code Section 24.2-671 governing the activities of the Virginia State Board of Elections.

Call to Order: Vice Chair Hughes called the meeting to order at 8:59 a.m.

Canvass of the June 18, 2024 Dual Party Primary Election: The June 18, 2024 Dual Party Primary Election results were reviewed and confirmed for each precinct by the Board.

Provisional Ballot Meeting:

(Closed Session)

At 9:37 a.m. Mr. Hughes motioned to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing provisional ballots submitted for the June 18, 2024 election. The motion was seconded by Ms. Hall. approved by a unanimous voice vote.

(Open Session)

At 9:42 a.m. Mr. Hughes moved to return to open meeting session. The motion was seconded by Ms. Hall. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote.
