a. After School Program

After school is going really well at this time. We have ninety-four registrations so far this year. This year was the first time since Covid that we decided to attend a fall field trip to the pumpkin patch at Wind Farms.

b. Fall Soccer

Fall soccer has been going well. We are in hopes that the rain will hold off so we are able to get practices and games in. We have a total of 221 registrations.

c. Youth Basketball & Tot Shots

For the youth basketball league, we have 64 registrations so far and will close on October 13th. Practices for basketball will begin on Monday, December 2, 2024 and games will start on Saturday, January 11, 2025.

d. 2nd Annual Trail or Treat

We are excited to be hosting the 2nd annual Trail or Treat event. Currently, we are preparing for the event. At this time, we are still in need of volunteers on the basketball court and on the trail. The event will be held on October 25, 2024. We are also looking for trunks for the event as well.

e. Reindeer Run- 1 Mile Kids Run and 5k

The Reindeer Run registration is currently open. We offer a 1mile run and a 5k as well. The race day will be held on December 7, 2024, at the Cool Spring Primary bus loop. We will start with the 1-mile race at 8:00a.m. and the 5K will follow the completion of the 1-mile starting around 8:30a.m.

a. King William Little League

Currently, we are in the fall ball season. At this time, we play games on Friday nights and Saturday mornings. Our season will run until November 2, 2024.
