The King William County Electoral Board met at the office of the General Registrar, on Friday, June 20, 2025, to consider the canvass resulting from the June 17, 2025 Democratic Party Primary Election. Canvass of the votes by the Board is provided for in Virginia Code Section 24.2-671 governing the activities of the Virginia State Board of Elections.

Canvass Meeting: The Board continued the canvass ascertaining the results of the June 17, 2025, Democratic Party Primary Election received by the Central Absentee Precinct.

(Closed Session)

At 1:07 p.m. Mr. Breeden motioned to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing provisional ballots submitted for the June 17, 2025 election. The motion was seconded by Ms. Hall. approved by a unanimous voice vote.

(Open Session)

At 1:15 p.m. Mr. Breeden moved to return to open meeting session. The motion was seconded by Ms. Hall. The motion was approved by a unanimous voice vote.
