

**King William County Electoral Board
Meeting Minutes – November 12, 2025**

The King William County Electoral Board met at the office of the General Registrar, on Wednesday, November 12, 2025, to Canvass the results of the Post Election results and to hold the provisional ballot meeting for the November 4, 2025 General and Special Election. Canvass of the votes by the Board is provided for in Virginia Code Section 24.2-67.1 governing the activities of the Virginia State Board of Elections.

Canvass of the November 4, 2025 General Election: The November 4, 2025 General Election results were reviewed and confirmed for each precinct by the Board.

Provisional Ballot Meeting:

(Closed Session)

At 9:11 a.m. Mr. Breeden motioned to go into closed session for the purpose of reviewing provisional ballots submitted for the November 4, 2025 election. The motion was seconded by Ms. Hall. Approved by a unanimous voice vote.

(Open Session)

At 10:37 a.m. Mr. Breeden moved to return to open meeting session. The motion seconded by Ms. Hall. Approved by a unanimous voice vote.
